The AMBAG Board of Directors endorsed Amendment No. 10 to the *FY 2006/07 to FY 2008/09 Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program* on September 12, 2007 by approving Resolution No. 2007-14, copy attached. Please initiate the process by which this amendment is processed for state and federal approval.

In accordance with SAFETEA-LU, MTIP Amendment No. 10 is financially constrained to reasonably available resources and adequate public review opportunity was provided. Copy of AMBAG 2006/07 - 09/10 FSTIP Financial Summary form for Amendment No 10 is enclosed (Attachment A).

**OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE  
ASSOCIATION OF MONTEREY BAY AREA GOVERNMENTS  
ADOPTING AMENDMENT NO. 10 TO THE FY 2006/07 to FY 2009/10 MONTEREY BAY  
METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments has been designated by the Governor of the State of California as the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Monterey Bay area; and

**WHEREAS**, Title 23 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 450, and Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 613, require that in each urbanized area, as a condition to the receipt of Federal capital or operating assistance, the MPO carries out, in cooperation with State, local agencies and publicly owned operators of mass transportation services, a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process that results in plans and programs consistent with the comprehensively planned development of the urbanized area; and

**WHEREAS**, AMBAG has developed a four-year program of projects, consistent with AMBAG's *2005 Monterey Bay Metropolitan Transportation Plan*, the *2006 State Transportation Improvement Program*, the *2006 State Highway Operation and Protection Program*, and the area's Regional Transportation Improvement Programs and Short Range Transit Plans; and


**WHEREAS**, SHOPP program provides funds to MPOs, and transit agencies to invest in projects that increase safety and Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP) Amendment Number 10 adjusts the MTIP to include adjusted SHOPP funds for FY 2006/07, 2007/08 and 2008/09; and


