Re: Administrative Amendment No. 4 to the 2006 FTIP

Dear Mr. Aljabiry:

The Kern Council of Governments' Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) policy is to compile administrative amendments that are made on an as needed basis and report to Caltrans, federal transportation agencies, and air quality agencies. The City of Delano requested revisions to project record KER060404. Administrative Amendment No. 4 to the 2006 FTIP has been included in this report. The Kern COG staff reviewed the member agency request and has agreed to make administrative revisions to the 2006 FTIP reflecting changes to the project below:

Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP)

KER060404 (Cecil Avenue Project)

The City of Delano requested to advance a project on Cecil Avenue, from fiscal year 07/08 to fiscal year 06/07 as well as move \$154,516 (federal \$136,800 and local \$17,716) from fiscal year 08/09 to fiscal year 06/07. The Cecil Avenue project is part of the Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP) lump sum listing for KER060404. With this amendment the other "preventative maintenance at various locations" projects would be removed from the lump sum listing. The project that is listed for fiscal year 08/09, on Countyline Rd, is still considered fully funded.


Kern COG concurs with the request to expedite the appropriate changes listed above as part of Amendment No. 4 (administrative amendment) to the 2006 FTIP because: 1) the programming year can be changed within the triennial element; 2) there is no change in total RSTP funding; 3) project is ready to be implemented; and 4) the project is exempt under Table 2 of 40 CFR 93.126.

Revisions have been made to California Transportation Improvement Program (CTIPS) database and are reflected in the enclosure.
