FORMAL AMENDMENT NO. 8 TO THE 2007 FTIP

Enclosed for your review and approval is a copy of Amendment No. 8 to the 2007 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) requested by the Kern Council of Governments (Kern COG). Kern COG, at a regularly scheduled meeting held on March 20, 2008, adopted Amendment No. 8 to the 2007 FTIP. Also enclosed is an executed copy of the authorizing resolution, Resolution # 08-13, financial plan, and amendment report. Projects in this amendment have been through the MPO approval process in the CTIPS database.

STATE HIGHWAY OPERATIONS AND PROTECTION PROGRAM OF PROJECTS

- Revise KER060202 collision reduction – changes to lump sum listing including deletion of one SR 178 guardrail project and addition of one SR 119 project, one SR 178 project, and two SR 184 projects.
- Revise KER060210 mandates – change to the description, decrease in funding by \$7,000, and moves funding from fiscal year 06/07 to 07/08.

SAFETY PROGRAM OF PROJECTS

- Highway Bridge Program (HBP) Revise KER060601 – Per HBP list dated 12/27/07 move projects in fiscal year 10/11 to fiscal year 11/12 and beyond. Amendment No. 8 only includes projects moved to fiscal year 11/12.
- Rail Grade Crossing (Section 130) Revise KER060602 – addition of two projects to fiscal year 07/08. The project intersections are Poplar Ave at BNSF and Reina Road at BNSF.
- Hazard Elimination Safety (HES) Revise KER060606 – addition of a Taft project to install curb ramps to fiscal year 07/08.
- Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) Revise KER060608 – addition of two Wasco crosswalk projects to fiscal years 07/08 and 08/09.

REGIONAL SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM OF PROJECTS

- Arvin: Revise KER060401 – move construction phase from FY 10/11 to FY 07/08

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CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR QUALITY PROGRAM OF PROJECTS

- McFarland: Delete KER060508 – agency was able to procure free bus shelters and will no longer pursue the CMAQ funding.

RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM OF PROJECTS

- Friends of Jawbone: Introduce KER071003 – re-print “Friends of Jawbone Map #7”
- Friends of Jawbone: Introduce KER071004 – expand visitor center facilities
- Friends of Jawbone: Introduce KER071005 – assist Bureau of Land Management with equipment purchase
- Friends of Jawbone: Introduce KER071006 – assist Bureau of Land Management with trail maintenance
- California Trail Users Coalition: Introduce KER071007 – installation of CXT SST “Tioga Special”

AMENDMENT NO. 8 TO THE 2007 FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Kern Council of Governments (Kern COG) is a Regional Transportation Planning Agency (RTPA) and a Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO); and

WHEREAS, the MPO is required to develop, maintain and endorse the 2007 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) with a Biannual Program of Projects for federal funding assistance; and

WHEREAS, the 2007 FTIP for the Kern region is a four-year schedule of multi modal transportation project improvements of major freeways, expressways, arterials, urban collectors, bikeways, transit, rail and aviation facilities; and

WHEREAS, in order to maintain a current and up-to-date 2008 FTIP, amendments and minor adjustments are required from time to time; and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 8 to the 2007 FTIP is consistent with elements of the Destination 2030 Regional Transportation Plan (2030 RTP); and

WHEREAS, the 2007 FTIP, prepared by the Kern Council of Governments, is financially constrained and reflects state guidelines and regulation requiring the preparation of a TIP in the urbanized areas; and

WHEREAS, the programming changes contained in this amendment are exempt from conformity requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Amendment No. 8 to 2007 FTIP is consistent with the State Implementation Plan (SIP); and

WHEREAS, the Kern Council of Governments (Kern COG) has an adopted Public Involvement Procedures and Policies; and

WHEREAS, the document has been made available for review by residents of Kern County through an advertised public hearing as prescribed in the Kern COG Public Involvement Procedures and Policies; and

WHEREAS, this amendment was circulated and reviewed by the member agencies of the Kern Council of Governments, representing their technical and management staffs, and representatives of other governmental agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Kern Council of Governments is the state recognized clearinghouse (Executive Order 12372) for this area and the aforementioned formal review shall constitute the official clearinghouse process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT Kern COG amends the 2007 FTIP as follows:

Amendment No. 8 to the 2007 FTIP will amend the State Highway Operations and Protection Program, Safety Program, Regional Surface Transportation Program, Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Program, and Recreational Trails Program. All changes are shown in the attachment to and made a part of this Resolution No. 08-13 by this reference.




