Dear Ms. Kiser:

With this letter, I am transmitting Administrative Amendment No. 6 to California's 2006/07-2008/09 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP), which makes minor modifications to the FSTIP. Two minor changes are made to the State Highway and Operation Protection Program (SHOPP) Grouped Project listing for the rural, non-Metropolitan Planning Organization portion of the State. The Collision Reduction Grouped Project Listing is increased by \$759,000 in Fiscal Year (FY) 2006/07 for the construction phase of a Mendocino County two-way left turn lane project. The Bridge Preservation Grouped Project Listing is increased by \$307,000 in FY 2006/07 for a Del Norte County Hardscrabble Creek bridge replacement project. The addition of these funds does not exceed 20 percent of the specific grouped project listing, nor are the increases greater than \$2 million.

These projects are in unclassified areas of the state for air conformity. This amendment does not affect timely implementation of Transportation Control Measures or financial constraints, and does not result in major scope changes. These changes are included in the California Transportation Improvement Program System.

Since administrative amendments do not require Federal Highway Administration and/or Federal Transit Administration approval, this FTIP amendment has been amended into California's 2006/07-2008/09 FSTIP.
