Dear Ms. Kiser and Mr. Sukys:

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is transmitting the following amendment to the California 2006/07 – 2009/10 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP) for your approval. This amendment modifies and adds projects in the rural, non-Metropolitan Planning Organization portion of the state.

<u>No.</u>	<u>Description</u>
25	Truck Parking Facilities

- This amendment programs a new iPark Project “Improved Parking Information and Reservations for Truckers”. Funding has been made available per Section 1305 of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users. A total of \$5,455,372 is programmed in Fiscal Year 2007/08 for this project. No match is required.

I am also recommending that the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and Federal Transit Administration approve this Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) Amendment No. 25 for inclusion into California’s FSTIP.

Based upon correspondence from FHWA dated May 27, 2008, projects in non-metropolitan isolated non-attainment areas of the State do not need to meet project conformity to be included in the FSTIP. However, such projects must comply with project level conformity requirements when a Federal action such as a National Environmental Protection Agency decision or obligation of funds, is taken on the project.

The financial impacts of this amendment are compatible with anticipated revenues in the FSTIP Financial Plan and do not significantly affect the overall financial analysis.

Projects included in this FTIP, in fiscal years beyond the four-year cycle of the current FSTIP, are not approved as part of this FTIP amendment and are shown for information only. These projects are included and submitted by Caltrans through the California Transportation Improvement Program System.

Please note that the approval of this amendment does not constitute an eligibility determination for the projects that are federally funded.
