Dear Ms. Falsetti:

Under authority granted to me by the Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) Regional Council, I hereby approve and transmit amendment #06-23 for Various Counties. The amendment adds a National Scenic Byways project titled "Palms to Pines Corridor Management Plan" to the lump sum #SCAG011.

This amendment:

- Is consistent with the amended 2008 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP): and
- Does not affect the regional emissions analysis for the RTIP;
- Does not affect the timely implementation of the Transportation Control Measures;
- Does not adversely impact financial constraint.

Furthermore, SCAG through its function as the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has found the attached project to conform to the applicable State Implementation Plan and to be consistent with the 2008 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) and not impact the timely implementation of transportation control measures.
