With this letter, I am forwarding the San Joaquin Council of Governments (SJCOG) administrative amendment #7. This amendment reduces Federal Transit Administration 5307 funding and increases State Transit Development Account funding by the same amount for several projects in fiscal year 2006-2007.

These changes are consistent with the administrative amendment procedures. The SJCOG certifies that the amendment does not affect air quality conformity, timely implementation of transportation control measures or financial constraints, or result in major scope change. The SJCOG submits this amendment through the California Transportation Improvement Program System. See attached.
