within the FTIP**

Dear Ms. Falsetti:

As the Executive Director for the Stanislaus Council of Governments, I hereby approve **Administrative Amendment # 2** to the 2007 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) to change the list of projects in the State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP).

SHOPP: The current Lump Sum program for the SHOPP – Collision Reduction Program consists of one project programmed in FFY 08/09. This modification will add one project in FFY 06/07.

REASON:

Caltrans has programmed a non-regionally significant SHOPP Collision Reduction project in the City of Riverbank. "SR 108 Signal Project at Jackson Avenue". SHOPP Safety Improvements 201.010 program; CTIPS ID# 114-0000-0135; PPNO: 0085; EA# 0H0301

This amendment meets the criteria for changes that may be made administratively (Type 1):

- It represents a modification of a grouped category;
- This change is consistent with changes authorized administratively under #1-A-7 of the Procedures for Federal Statewide Transportation Program Modifications.
- Added project does not affect the air quality conformity determination;
- The implementation of Transportation Control Measures (TCM) has not been adversely affected;
- The StanCOG FTIP remains financially constrained;

This administrative amendment will be forwarded to Caltrans for review and information. Since this amendment was accomplished administratively, a resolution from the Stanislaus Council of Governments Policy Board is not required.
