The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has completed the review of the following amendment to the Metropolitan Transportation Commission's (MTC) 2008/09 – 2011/12 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP):

The amendment includes projects with funding from the Surface Transportation Program, State Transportation Improvement Program, State Highway Operation and Protection Program, Federal Earmarks, Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program, Highway Safety Improvement Program, Highway Maintenance Program, Highway Bridge Program, Safe Routes to School Program, High Risk Rural Road Program, State Minor Program, Federal Railroad Administration's High-Speed Rail Program, Proposition 1B – Transportation Bond Program, and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) 5310 Program. <p>See enclosure.</p>

MTC has certified that the amendment is financially constrained, does not change air quality conformity, and meets the requirements of public involvement procedures adopted by MTC.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to me by the Director of Caltrans, I approve MTC's Amendment Number 47. I also recommend that the Federal Highway Administration and FTA approve this FTIP amendment for inclusion into California's 2009 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). Projects included in this FTIP amendment, in fiscal years not within the four-year cycle of the current FSTIP, are not approved as part of this FTIP amendment and are shown for information only. Approval of this amendment does not constitute an eligibility determination of projects for federal funding.
