Dear Ms. Kiser and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, I am transmitting Administrative Modification No. 31 to California's 2008/09-2011/12 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP), which makes minor modifications to the rural, non-MPO portion of the FSTIP.

- Highway Maintenance Grouped Project Listing. Project EA 346090 is added to this grouped project listing. The project is for maintenance asphalt concrete overlay and is located in Mono County at Mammoth Lakes. This modification adds \$4,826,000 in Fiscal Year (FY) 2009/10.
- Safe Routes to School, 100 percent Federal, Grouped Project Listing. Funding for widening, reconstructing and re-striping the Clearlake Dam Road bicycle lane is increased by \$27,000 for the preliminary engineering phase in FY 2009/10.
- Scenic Byways Grouped Project Listing. This modification adds \$196,000 of federal Scenic Byway funds, and \$49,000 of local match for the Highway 395 Corridor Management Plan project in FY 2009/10. The project is located in Mono County.


These changes are submitted as an administrative modification. The changes are within the quadrennial element; do not reflect a change in the design concept or scope of the project, or impact financial constraints. Funding is available for these modifications. In addition, there are no projects in this Administrative Modification No. 31 that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.
