The California Department of Transportation has completed the review of the following amendment to the San Luis Obispo Council of Governments' (SLOCOG) 2008/09 - 2011/12 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP):

15	Federal and State <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This amendment consists of the addition of two SHOPP projects in San Luis Obispo County: one project for the Collision Reduction lump sum and one project for the Roadway Preservation lump sum.

The updated programming is for projects in an air quality attainment area that is exempt from the conformity determination requirement. The SLOCOG Board Resolution adopting this FTIP amendment certifies that the amendment is financially constrained, and meets the requirements of public involvement procedures adopted by SLOCOG.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to me, I approve SLOCOG's Amendment Number 15. I also recommend that the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration approve this FTIP amendment for inclusion into California's 2009 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). Projects included in this FTIP amendment, in fiscal years not within the four-year cycle of the current FSTIP, are not approved as part of this FTIP amendment and are shown for information only. Approval of this amendment does not constitute an eligibility determination of project for federal funding.
