The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has completed the review of the following amendment to the Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments' (AMBAG) 2010/11 - 2013/14 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP):

3	State and Local Elements <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Adds or deletes projects from various funding programs in AMBAG region. The amendment includes projects with funding from the State Transportation Improvement Program, State Highway Operation and Protection Program, and the Highway Safety Improvement Program.

The updated programming is for projects in air quality attainment area that is exempt from the conformity determination requirement. The AMBAG Board Resolution adopting this FTIP amendment certifies that the amendment is financially constrained, and meets the requirements of public involvement procedures per 23 Code of Federal Regulations Part 450.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to me by the Director of Caltrans, I approve AMBAG's Amendment No. 3. I also recommend that the Federal Highway Administration and the Federal Transit Administration approve this FTIP amendment for inclusion into California's 2011 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). Projects included in this FTIP amendment, in fiscal years not within the four-year cycle of the current FSTIP, are not approved as part of this FTIP amendment and are shown for information only. Approval of this amendment does not constitute an eligibility determination of project for federal funding.

Projects included in this FTIP amendment are submitted by AMBAG through the California Transportation Improvement Program System (CTIPS). Caltrans concerns, if any, are reflected
