**Subject: BCAG 2011 FTIP Modification #05– Request for State Approval for Various Projects**

Mr. Yazdi:

The Butte County Association of Governments (BCAG) administratively amended the 2011 Butte County FTIP #05. BCAG is respectfully requesting approval for this modification. The purpose of this modification is:

1. Update the Local Highway Bridge Program listing for "Grouped Projects" for a local Butte County Bridge
2. Advance the Butte Regional Transit Center Project from FFY 13/14 to FFY 10/11 and increase the CMAQ funding for the project from \$1.5 million to \$1.8 million (20%).
3. Update the Caltrans SHOPP Bridge Preservation "Grouped Projects" for the purpose of adding two new projects in Butte County
