Dear Mr. Hannon and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) transmits Administrative Modification No. 34 to the California 2010/11-2013/14 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP) which makes minor modification to the Rural, non-Metropolitan Planning Organization portion of the FSTIP. This administrative modification includes:

- Grouped Projects for State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) Emergency Response Program – Modifies the funding and revises the backup listing to add a project located in Siskiyou County totaling \$1.8 million.
- Grouped Projects for (SHOPP) Mobility Program – Revises the backup listing to update the delivery schedule for a project in Humboldt County. No change in total project cost.
- Grouped Projects for Bike/Pedestrian Facilities for Attainment Areas – Revises the backup listing to modify the funding for the City of Ferndale project. No change in cost and delivery schedule.
- McCann Ferry Improvement Project – Revises the delivery year and moves funding of the Right of Way project component from Fiscal Year (FY) 11/12 to FY 12/13.
- Dorsey Drive Interchange – Minor technical correction to the project description. No change in project scope, cost and delivery schedule.


These programming changes are consistent with the FSTIP Amendment and Administrative Modification Procedures and have no impact on the rural non-MPO financial constraint or air quality conformity. In addition, there are no projects in this administrative modification that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.

Since administrative modifications do not require Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and/or Federal Transit Administration (FTA) approval, these changes have been incorporated into California's 2011 FSTIP.
