The California Department of Transportation has completed the review of the following amendments to the Sacramento Area Council of Governments' (SACOG) 20010/11 - 2013/14 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP):

No. Description

20 **State, Local and Transit Elements**

- This amendment adds or modifies individual and group listed projects from various funding sources in various counties. It includes projects with funding from the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program, the State Highway Operation and Protection Program, the Surface Transportation Program, State Bond, Federal Demonstration, the State Transportation Improvement Program, Federal Transit Agency (FTA) Sections: 5307, 5309, 5311, 5316, and 5317 and local funds.

The SACOG board resolutions adopting these FTIP amendments certify that projects included meet all applicable transportation planning requirements per Title 23 Code of Federal Regulation (CFR) Part 450 and satisfy the applicable air quality conformity requirements.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to me by the Director of Caltrans, I approve SACOG's Amendments Number 20. I also recommend that the Federal Highway Administration and FTA approve these FTIP amendments for inclusion into California's 2011 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). Projects included in these FTIP amendments, in fiscal years not within the four-year cycle of the current FSTIP, are not approved as part of these FTIP amendments and are shown for information only. Approval of this amendment does not constitute an eligibility determination of project for federal funding.
