Please be advised that SJCOG made changes to the 2011 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). The SJCOG Executive Director has the authority to approve all administrative modifications.

The proposed modifications are consistent with the 2011 Regional Transportation Plan as amended and the Public Participation Plan (as amended) adopted by the SJCOG Board.

FTIP Administrative Modification #19 amends the following existing projects in the 2011 FTIP:

- (1) Various Agencies, Grouped Projects for Transportation Enhancements (CTIPS# 212-0000-0554) increase \$200,000 in RSTP funds in FFY 11/12 and update the backup list.

The required documentation is enclosed.

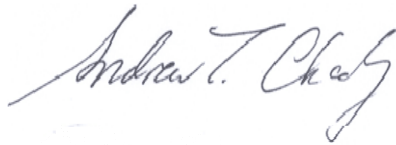
