The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has completed the review of the following amendment to the San Luis Obispo Council of Governments' (SLOCOG) 2010/11 - 2013/14 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP):

No. Description

5 **State and Local Elements**

- This amendment addresses seven projects in San Luis Obispo County. It includes one group project listing with funding from the Highway Bridge Program and six individual projects with funding from the Surface Transportation Program, the State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP), the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), the Federal Discretionary Program and local funds.

The SLOCOG Board Resolution adopting this FTIP amendment certifies that the amendment is financially constrained, and meets the requirements of public involvement procedures adopted by SLOCOG and all applicable transportation planning requirements per Title 23 Code of Federal Regulations Part 450 and satisfies the applicable air quality conformity requirements.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to me by the Director of Caltrans, I approve SLOCOG's Amendment Number 5. I also recommend that the Federal Highway Administration and FTA approve this FTIP amendment for inclusion into California's 2011 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). Projects included in this FTIP amendment, in fiscal years not within the four-year cycle of the current FSTIP, are not approved as part of this FTIP amendment and are shown for information only. Approval of this amendment does not constitute an eligibility determination of project for federal funding.
