**Subject: Approval of TCAG 2011 FTIP/FSTIP Administrative Modification Amendment No. 29**

Dear Mr. Aljabiry:

Enclosed is the approval of Tulare County Association of Governments (TCAG) Administrative Modification Amendment No. 29 to the Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP) and 2011 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). Amendment No. 29 to the 2011 FTIP modifies one (1) currently programmed “Local Rehabilitation and Projects,” group listing. The group listing for local rehabilitation (TUL10-900) “Grouped project for pavement resurfacing and/or rehabilitation on the local roads system,” adds local funds (\$984,000) and “Earmark Reallocation Funds (SAFETEA-LU-City of Tulare: Agri-Center Interchange Project in the amount of \$983,928 (\$984,000 rounded in CTIPS) to the group listing for “Local Rehabilitation and Projects” in the 2011 FTIP (Attachment 2-displays the back up listing adding three projects in the City of Tulare). TCAG certifies that there are no projects in this Amendment No. 29 (administrative modification) included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review. An electronic copy, including the project summary and CTIPS pages will be sent with this transmittal. Amendment No. 29 to the 2011 FTIP is available online on TCAG’s website at <http://www.tularecog.org/>.

As per the December 15, 2011, letter delegating TCAG authority from Caltrans to approve Administrative Modification to the FSTIP and FTIP. TCAGs’ Executive director is delegated the authority to approve Administrative Modifications to the FSTIP in accordance with the revised FSTIP/FTIP Amendments and Administrative Modification Procedures dated June 3, 2011, by Federal Highway Administration (FHWA).

TCAG certifies that Amendment No. 29 to the FSTIP/FTIP is consistent with the FSTIP modification procedures and hereby approves Amendment No. 29.
