
We have reviewed the Amendment to the California Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) for Santa Barbara County Association of Governments, as identified in your letter of April 8, 2013. This amendment adds and amends funds for Federal Transit Administration (FTA) 5311 program.

We accept and approve this amendment in accordance with 23 CFR 450 and find that this STIP amendment was developed based on a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process in accordance with 23 USC 134 and 49 USC 5303.

These projects are either exempt under air quality conformity regulations or part of a conforming transportation plan. In addition, the funds programmed are consistent with anticipated revenues and the amendment does not conflict with current financial planning expectations.
