The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has completed the review of the following amendment to the Merced County Association of Governments' (MCAG) 2014/15 – 2017/18 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP):

- This amendment adds a new Section 130 Grade Crossing Project to the Grouped Projects for Railroad/Highway Crossing in the MCAG region funded from the federal railway highway crossings program.
