Dear Mr. Hamilton and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) transmits Administrative Modification No. 23 to the Rural non-Metropolitan Planning Organization area portion of the California 2015 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). This modification adds programming capacity in the amount of \$10.606 million that relies on the State's federal programming capacity. The financial plan will be updated to reflect this change in the next FSTIP amendment.

Administrative Modification #23 modifies the following existing projects in the 2015 FSTIP:

State and Local Elements:

Various Counties:

Proj #1: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0159, Grouped Project Listing for Safety Improvements – Highway Safety Improvement Program – increases the funding by \$7.102 million in various fiscal years (FY) and revises the detailed backup listing of projects.

Proj #2: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0065, Grouped Project Listing for State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) Bridge Rehabilitation and Reconstruction – increases the funding by \$72,000 in FY 16/17 and revises the detailed backup listing of projects.

Proj #3: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0069, Grouped Project Listing for Pavement Resurfacing and Rehabilitation – SHOPP Roadway Preservation – increases the funding by \$3.432 million in FY 15/16 and revises the detailed backup listing of projects.

These changes are consistent with the FSTIP Amendment and Administrative Modification Procedures and have no impact on the rural non-MPO financial constraint or air quality conformity. In addition, there are no projects in this administrative modification that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.
