Dear Mr. Lord and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) transmits Administrative Modification No. 28 to the Rural non-Metropolitan Planning Organization area portion of the California 2015 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). This modification reduces the programming capacity in the amount of \$13.6 million. The financial plan will be updated to reflect this change in the next FSTIP amendment.

Administrative Modification #28 modifies the following existing projects in the 2015 FSTIP:

**State and Local Elements:**

**Various Counties:**

Proj #1: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0160, Grouped Projects for Safety Improvement – Safe Routes to School Program – reduces the funding by \$897,000 in various fiscal years (FY) and revises the detailed backup listing of projects.

Proj #2: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0065, Grouped Project Listing for State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) Bridge Rehabilitation and Reconstruction – reduces the funding by \$13.2 million in various FYs and revises the detailed backup listing of projects.

Proj #3: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0066, Grouped Project Listing for SHOPP Collision Reduction Program – increases the funding by \$548,000 and revises the detailed backup listing of projects.

These changes are consistent with the FSTIP Amendment and Administrative Modification Procedures and have no impact on the rural non-MPO financial constraint or air quality conformity. In addition, there are no projects in this administrative modification that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.
