Dear Mr. Lord and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) transmits Administrative Modification No. 31 to the Rural non-Metropolitan Planning Organization area portion of the California 2015 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). This modification reduces the programming capacity in the amount of \$146 million. The financial plan will be updated to reflect this change in the next FSTIP amendment.

Administrative Modification #31 modifies the following existing projects in the 2015 FSTIP:

**State and Local Elements:**

**Calaveras County:**

Proj #1: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0368, Murphy's Grade Road Traffic Flow and Sidewalk Improvement – modifies the construction schedule from Fiscal Year (FY) 15/16 to FY 18/19 and change the fund source from Congestion Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) program funds to Local Advance Construction. No change in project scope and cost.

**Various Counties:**

Proj #2: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0029, Grouped Project Listing for Emergency Repair – State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) Emergency Response – reduces the funding by \$9.9 million in various FYs and revises the detailed backup listing of projects.

Proj #3: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0067, Grouped Project Listing for Safety Improvements – SHOPP Mobility – increases the funding by \$4.2 million in FY 17/18 and revises the detailed backup listing of projects.

Proj #4: CTIPS ID 230-0000-134, Grouped Project Listing for Safety Improvements – SHOPP Mandates – increases the funding by \$4.6 million in FY 17/18 and revises the detailed backup listing of projects.

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Proj #5: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0065, Grouped Project Listing for SHOPP Bridge Rehabilitation and Reconstruction – reduces the funding by \$145 million in various FYs and revises the detailed backup listing of projects.

These changes are consistent with the FSTIP Amendment and Administrative Modification Procedures and have no impact on the rural non-MPO financial constraint or air quality conformity. In addition, there are no projects in this administrative modification that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.

Since administrative modifications do not require Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and/or Federal Transit Administration (FTA) approval, these changes have been incorporated into California's 2015 FSTIP.
