Dear Mr. Lord and Mr. Sukys:

With this letter, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) transmits Amendment No. 15 to the Rural non-Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) area portion of the California 2015 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). This amendment modifies the programming of various grouped projects totaling \$89.130 million:

State and Local Elements:

Proj 1: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0320, Grouped Projects for State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP) Minor Program – increases total project cost by \$21.9 million in FFY 2015/16 and revises the detailed backup project listing.

Proj 2: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0266, Grouped Projects for Resurfacing and Rehabilitation – Highway Maintenance Program (HM1) – increases the total project cost by \$24.3 million in FFY 2015/16 and revises the detailed backup project listing.

Proj 3: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0390, Grouped Projects for Engineering – increases the funding by \$1.377 million in FFY 2015/16 as requested by HQ Local Assistance for statewide oversight and monitoring of local agency federal-aid projects.

Proj 4: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0029, Grouped Project Listing for Emergency Repair – SHOPP Emergency Response Program – increases the total project cost by \$17.9 million in various fiscal years and revises the detailed backup project listing.

Transit Element:

Proj 5: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0241, Grouped Project Listing for Operating Assistance to Transit Agencies (FTA 5311 and 5311f) – increases the total project cost by \$21.8 million in FFY 2014/15; adds new projects under FTA Grant CA-18-X077 and revises the detailed backup project listing.

Proj 6: CTIPS ID 230-0000-0361, Grouped Project Listing for Capital Assistance to Transit Agencies (FTA 5311 and 5311f) – increases the total project cost by \$1.6 million in FFY 2014/15; adds new projects under FTA Grant CA-18-X077 and revises the detailed backup project listing.

Documentation associated with this amendment include summary of changes, project documentation, and updated financial summary. This amendment was posted for public review and comment for fourteen (14) days that commenced on July 15, 2015 and ended on July 30, 2015 as required by FSTIP public participation plan. No comments were received during the public review period. In addition, there are no projects in this amendment that are included in any other amendment that is currently open for public review.

Projects in this amendment with funding beyond the four-year cycle of the current FSTIP are included for information only. These projects are included and submitted by Caltrans through the California Transportation Improvement Program System (CTIPS). In addition to being available in CTIPS, programming pages for each project are also included as part of *Attachment 1, Summary of Changes and Project Details*. The financial impact of this amendment is compatible with the anticipated revenues in the 2015 FSTIP Financial Plan and remains financially constrained as demonstrated in *Attachment 2, Financial Summary Tables*.


Based upon correspondence from FHWA dated May 27, 2008, projects in non-metropolitan isolated non-attainment areas of the State do not need to meet project conformity to be included in the FSTIP. However, such projects must comply with project level conformity requirements when a Federal action such as a National Environmental Protection Agency decision or obligation of funds, is taken on the project.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to me by the Director of Caltrans, I approve this FSTIP Amendment 15 for inclusion into California's FSTIP. I am also recommending that the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) approve this amendment. Please note that the approval of this amendment does not constitute an eligibility determination of projects for federal funding.
