The California Department of Transportation has completed the review of the following amendment to the San Joaquin Council of Governments' (SJCOG) 2014/15 - 2017/18 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP):

<u>No.</u>	<u>Description</u>
14	Local, State, and Transit Elements

- SJCOG is proposing a 2015 FTIP Amendment 14 and 2014 Regional Transportation Plan Amendment 2 and 2015 Conformity Analysis addressing 2008 Ozone and 2012 PM2.5 Standards for the 2014 RTP/2015 FTIP.
- For the 2015 FTIP, this amendment modifies and adds new projects in San Joaquin County funded from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) 5307 program, FTA 5339 program, Surface Transportation Program, Proposition 1B Program, Highway Bridge Program, Highway Maintenance Program, and State Highway Operation and Protection Minor Program.

The SJCOG board resolution adopting this FTIP amendment certifies that projects included meet all applicable transportation planning requirements per Title 23 Code of Federal Regulation Part 450 and satisfy the applicable air quality conformity requirements.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to me by the Director of Caltrans, I approve SJCOG's Amendment Number 14. I also recommend that Federal Highway Administration and FTA approve this FTIP amendment for inclusion into California's 2015 Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP). Projects included in this FTIP amendment, in fiscal years not within the four-year cycle of the current FSTIP, are not approved as part of this

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FTIP amendment and are shown for information only. Approval of this amendment does not constitute an eligibility determination of project for federal funding.
