Subject: Submittal of the Tulare County Association of Governments (TCAG) Amendment No. 17 to the 2015 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP)

Dear Mr. Aljabiry:

Enclosed for your review and approval is TCAG's Amendment No. 17 to the 2015 Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). Amendment No. 17 consists of the following changes:

CTIPS ID No. 215-0000-0591 FTA 5307: City of Porterville Transit. Electronic fare boxes. For FFY 2016/17, increases FTA 5307 amount from \$40k to \$280k and TDA amount from \$10k to \$70k.

CTIPS ID No. 215-0000-0617 Grouped Projects for Pavement Resurfacing and/or Rehabilitation on the State Highway System – Highway Maintenance (Using toll credits). Adds a new Highway Maintenance project in FFY 2016/17 in the amount of \$2.518M.

CTIPS ID No. 215-0000-0631 FTA 5307: Tulare City Transit. Transit Operations Assistance. Decreases FTA 5307 and TDA amounts from \$1.140M to \$790k in FFY 2015/16 and from \$1.140M to \$928k in FFY 2016/17.

CTIPS ID No. 215-0000-0643 FTA 5307: City of Porterville Transit. Safety and security improvements. For FFY 2016/17, increases FTA 5307 amount from \$20k to \$180k and LTF amount from \$5k to \$45k.

New Project: CTIPS ID No. 215-0000-0722 FTA 5307: Tulare City Transit. Transit Preventative Maintenance. New project for transit preventative maintenance activities funded with FTA 5307 and TDA funds. Total project cost is \$800,000.

New Project: CTIPS ID No. 215-0000-0723 FTA 5307: Porterville City Transit. Admin and Maintenance Facility. New project for design of new Porterville Transit Administration and Maintenance Facility. Funded with FTA 5307 and LTF funds. Total project cost is \$500,000.

New Project: CTIPS ID No. 215-0000-0724 FTA 5307: Porterville City Transit. Battery electric and PV System. New project for design and construction of battery electric infrastructure and PV system at transit center and bus yard. Funded with FTA 5307 and LTF funds. Total project cost is \$1,700,000.

New Project: CTIPS ID No. 215-0000-0725 FTA 5307: Porterville City Transit. Support vehicle purchase. New project for the purchase of non-revenue transit support vehicles. Funded with FTA 5307 and LTF funds. Total project cost is \$160,000.

STBGP Revenue Adjustments. Amendment No. 17 includes an adjustment to the 2015 FTIP financial revenue table for STBGP. The change reflects the revised STBGP apportionment estimate for FFY 2015/16 per email from Lilibeth Green dated 4/4/2016.

This amendment to the 2015 FTIP contains project phases and/or projects that meet all applicable transportation planning requirements per 23 CFR Part 450 and 40 CFR Part 93. This amendment meets the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) requirement under 49 USC, 5307 (c)(1) through (7) that public notice of public involvement activities and time established for public review as adopted in the 2015 Public Participation Plan (PPP) and comment on the TIP satisfy the Program of Projects (POP) requirements of the Section 5307 Program. Amendment No. 17 is a Type 3 amendment.

*Conformity Requirements: The proposed project changes have been determined to be exempt from the requirement that a conformity determination and/or regional emissions analysis be performed per 40 CFR 93.126, 93.127, or 93.128. Because the projects are exempt, no further conformity determination is required. In addition, the projects and/or project phases contained in **Amendment No. 17** do not interfere with the timely implementation of any approved Transportation Control Measures (TCMs)*

The Summary of Changes Table and CTIPS Project Listing is included in **Attachment No. 1**. **Attachment No. 2** consists of the Financial Summary Tables and **Attachment No. 3** is the MPO Fund Type Report which demonstrates financial constraint for this amendment. **Attachment No. 4** is the Highway Maintenance program grouped project listing.

As per TCAG's adopted 2015 Public Participation Plan (PPP), the public review and comment period was open for 14 days commencing on Tuesday, June 14, 2016 and ending on Tuesday, June 28, 2016. No comments were received for this amendment.
