

**Project Summary:** The overall Vasco Road Safety and Transit Enhancement project consists of three separate segments to provide improved access to the Altamont Commuter Express (ACE) rail service. The overall project has been segmented into three sub-projects for implementation:

- Sub-Project #27.1: Straighten Vasco Road.
- Sub-Project #27.2: Improvements to the Vasco Road commuter parking facility for the ACE station.
- Sub-Project #27.3: Parking Structure for Valley Center Project

The approved application covers Phase 1, environmental studies and preliminary engineering for Segment 1 (Sub-Project #27.1). This segment is to improve the alignment of and provide passing lanes on Vasco Road between the City of Livermore in Alameda and the Contra Costa County line. This will allow transit bus service from east Contra Costa County (Cities of Antioch, Brentwood, Clayton, and Discovery Bay) to the ACE stations near Livermore. Planned work is to reconstruct Vasco Road on an improved alignment and grade, widen shoulders, and add passing lanes to improve traffic operations and safety

**Prior TCRP Action:**

- Original application was approved on March 28, 2001 (TA-01-06) for \$150,000 for Phase 1. A delegated allocation of \$150,000 was made to Phase 1.
- The funding plan was updated based on the 2002 STIP Adoption (G-02-04) on April 4, 2004. The 2002 STIP programmed \$1,400,000 of STIP-RIP funds to Phase 4.
- The funding plan was updated based on the 2004 STIP Adoption (G-04-07) on August 5, 2004.
- An amendment was approved August 18, 2005 (TAA-05-15) to program \$6,350,000 to Phase 3 and update the project schedule and funding plan. An AB 1335 Letter of No Prejudice of \$6,350,000 for Phase 3 was deferred due to pending legislation.
- An AB 1335 Letter of No Prejudice was approved on September 29, 2005 for \$6,350,000 of Local and Federal funds for Phase 3 (TL-05-03).
- An amendment was approved on February 14, 2008 (TAA-07-44) to update project schedule and funding plan.
- An allocation of \$6,350,000 in TCRP funds to reimburse the previously approved AB 1335 Letter of No Prejudice was approved under Resolution TFP-07-10, February 14, 2008.

**Status of Conditions:** No conditions set.

**Discussion/Issues:** Approval of the project for future consideration of funding of the final environmental document, Mitigated Negative Declaration, by the CTC occurred January 23, 2003 under Resolution E-03-05.
