

**Project Summary:** The overall project is to widen Peach Avenue to four lanes between Belmont and Butler Avenues (approximately 2 miles). The project will improve the linkage between Route 99 and the Fresno-Yosemite International Airport and improve passenger and freight services.

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**Prior TCRP Action:**

- Original application was approved on May 2, 2001 (TA-01-07) for \$10,000,000 for all Phases. A delegated allocation of \$150,000 was made to Phase 1 and \$450,000 was made to Phase 2.
- An application amendment was approved April 27, 2006 (TAA-06-26). The application amendment deleted the pedestrian overcrossings, redistributed \$50,000 from Phase 4 to Phase 2, redistributed \$100,000 from Phase 4 to Phase 3, and updated the project schedule and funding plan. A reallocation of \$344,000 was made to Phase 1 and Phase 2 (TFP-06-08) and an additional allocation of \$50,000 was made to Phase 2 (TFP-06-09).
