The particular nature and circumstances of this potential claim are described as follows:


Based upon the conversation between KFM and Caltrans' representatives on Tuesday, November 23, 2004 and Friday, November 19, 2004, KFM is filing a potential claim for the UT Examination of the PJP Welds.

Caltrans' position as stated in these meetings, that all testing and acceptance criteria are provided for in the contract documents such that an acceptable procedure can be successfully developed and relied upon for the verification of weld depth and weld quality of all PJP Welds, is in dispute.

KFM's position is that no information is provided in contract documents to comply with the requirements to develop and rely upon such a procedure. The contract refers to AWS D1.5 for the criteria; however, D1.5 does not address UT of PJP Welds for depth or quality.
