MCM is hereby initiating this Notice of a Potential Claim in dispute of the last minute changes to the pipe hangar plan. MCM had submitted plans that were approved several months prior to installation. Materials had been procured, embeds had been fabricated and installed per the approved drawings. Just prior to placing lost deck, the state designer chose to change the approved hangar at Hinge FW. It is MCM's standpoint that this constitutes a CCO.
