Monday: 4/16/2007 0800-1630 = 8 hrs

- Went through e-mails and found old concurrences on CCO's and placed them in PMIV.
- Gave CCO 035 to Gary for signature and to send to the DO for processing.
- Reviewed CPM update regarding CCO's and gave Don Ross a report on the timeline up to 8/20/2006 data date.

Tuesday: 4/17/2007 0800-1630 = 8 hrs

- Had meeting with Gary to discuss the plan sheet library. "Official" plan sheets in the plan sheet library only. This would include only approved CCO plan sheets and plan sheets that have been addressed in an ATP to ABFJV. Unofficial (for pricing) will be done through PMIV, but not through the plan sheet library. Joint CCO meeting with ABFJV set for 5/3/2007 at 10 AM. Send Contractor CCO log to ABFJV every two weeks after our internal CCO meeting.
- Worked in PMIV trying to get a report showing CCO's and RFI's. I was able to generate a report, but the RFI's are not in numerical order. Problem in PMIV. Can't sort using the "order" function. Need to talk to PMIV about getting this function working.

Wednesday: 4/18/2007 0800-1630 = 8 hrs

- Worked on updating CCO 004 DRB Agreement.
- Revised CCO 039 (PMIV field report module). New estimate after removing PDA's is \$197,300. Under the \$200K limit, so it can be field approved. Modified concurrence memo and gave to Keith and Darryl for review.
- Researched plan sheets 538 and 539 for Gary regarding the recent history of changes.
- Went over to ABFJV WDC and met one of my counter-parts, Ben Olson. We went over the plan sheet library, reporting functions (to help them generate some reports they wanted), and just to generally meet to promote open communication between ABF and CT.


Thursday: 4/19/2007 0800-1630 = 8 hrs

- Safety meeting in the morning. George chaired the meeting today. Met with Dan and Ben of ABFJV with Darryl and George to generally meet and go over how we want the plan sheet library and draft plans to be communicated.
  - Everyone agrees that the plan sheet library should only have approved plan sheets. This would include only executed CCO plan sheets and plan sheets with an ATP.
  - Draft plan sheets for pricing will go through PMIV, but not be in the plan sheet library. Dan and Ben both want to see "draft" stamped on the plan sheets so they can distinguish what are "official" plans vs. what are sheets for pricing.
- Worked on CCO 039.

Friday: 4/20/2007 0800-1630 = 8 hrs

- Worked most of the day on getting CCO 004 package to DO for HQ I&A.
- Also worked on PMIV and diary.
