Sunday, October 7, 2007

Travel to Shanghai, China, via Tokyo. Arrived at airport at 9:40pm local time. Hotel at 11:00pm. Accompanied by Rick Morrow, and met up with TYLin reps, Marwan Nader and James Duxbury. Brian Boal and Warren Collins also were in Shanghai after attending a pre-weld meeting at JWS in Japan late last week.

Tuesday, October 9, 2007
