- Worked on miscellaneous job related issues.

Tuesday

- Worked on miscellaneous job related issues. Spoke to Tom Pile – Sup. Engineer Sacramento concrete Translab. Asked him if SCC mock-up test result can be considered acceptable if acceptance criteria A from the special provisions regarding 25 mm elevation difference did not met, and if it is important to be within 25 mm. He said that the test can be accepted and 25 mm is not important.

Worked on miscellaneous job related issues. In the morning visited the job site. There was no visible damage or displacement of the erected falsework after the early morning earthquake. I have talked to Steve Marko and Jim Davidson, asked them to inspect falsework in detail from the foundation up to ensure there was no damage or displacement. Also suggested to set permanent marks on the falsework elements to monitor possible displacement in the future. In the afternoon talked to Jim Davidson and asked him to perform another flow mock-up test on SCC. He agreed. Also asked him to provide CT with coordinates of the W2 bent cap and steel forms points so CT will be able to verify them in the office and in the field.
