Monday, April 7, 2008

Attended weekly "Champions" meeting in am.

Met Jerry Kent, ABF, at gate to Skyway to install an ABF "double lock" padlock to allow access of ABF surveyors onto the end of the Skyway to control work on E2.

Received call from Pat Hassett regarding resolution of hours expended in providing an adjustment of compensation on CCO 19. We are in agreement with total hours for Hassett Engineering (2734hrs total). I also inquired about the time expended "packaging" up submittals for distribution when complete, since this work had be shifted from Hassett to CTLLC. Pat estimated it had required between 1 and 2 hours per submittal for the administrative effort to "package" and distribute the submittal. This is consistent with CTLLC's estimate of ½ to 1 ½ hours, or an average of one hour per submittal.
