

In the morning I visited Berth 7 with Masoud Modanlu to discuss the assembly operations with him. While we were discussing this, Masoud recognized that only Leo Vega and Henry Wheat were at the site at this time. He then asked Leo Vega where they were working and if they were doing any work related to the E2 Falsework. Leo replied and said that Paul Eckstrom and Richard Yambao were working at the pile barges.

At this time Steve Marko interrupted and demanded what business of ours it was where his employees were. I replied that it is standard Caltrans procedure to document workers operations during the day and report on their hours. He then very rudely and unprofessionally told us that that was not how it was going to work on his jobsite, and that we were not to ask his workers where or what they are doing. I responded that if his foreman did not want to tell us what his workers were doing, he did not have to. It was a matter of cooperation and teamwork. If he didn't want to do it, it was up to him. At this point, Mr. Marko continued to be unprofessional, so Masoud and I left Berth 7. We then reported Mr. Marko's actions to Saman Soheilifard.

I later spoke with James Davidson about the incident. He assured me that he would speak with Mr. Marko.

Saman and I later visited E2 to check on the progress. The final two pipe columns were in place and ready to be welded. Mark MacDonald let us know that the final pieces most likely would be inserted in the afternoon.
