Monday, July 07, 2008

Attended Champions meeting – discussed ABF's proposal to use Skyway for access to E2.

At Team China teleconference, it was requested that I inquire with ABF re: the status of the John Barshum report on crescent cracking on u-ribs.

Attended mandatory marine safety training in morning provided by the District Construction Safety & Mark Vilcheck.

Blue Tag teleconference held at 5pm. I did not participate.

Prior to core team, met with Mike Flowers, Brian Petersen and David Gainey to discuss the upcoming marine safety presentation by David at tomorrows tailgate meeting.
