- Visited Pier W2 to evaluate discrepancies between ABF and Caltrans locations of construction stakes. I checked the inverse distances between various stakes, and determined that the ABF stakes are “internally consistent”. I discussed this with D. Adams, ABF surveyor, who also had done independent checks on the locations of the construction stakes, and his checks also confirmed that the stakes were in proper orientation with each other. As a result, I believe that ABF has properly placed construction marks (stakes) on the Pier E2 cap beam.
