Description of Operation:

Arrived to find the contractor having an extended stretch and flex this morning. They were discussing hearing loss, with someone from their occupational health department. The crew got on the boat around 7:00 AM and got to the DB-5 and began to get it up and running from the rainy weekend. Since they had to wrap everything up in preparation for the bad weather, everything had to be brought back out. They were able to place gangways and run power cords through 8:00 AM. Once the power was up and running some workers began gridding the rust off the weld joint for the pile splicing that was to happen today. I left the site around 8:15 AM to go to XKT, but once I arrived at the dock I was informed that the trip was canceled. As I walked back to the trailer, Thanh Le was on his way to the DB-5 to observe the operation. I updated him on what was to happen today. Namely that they planned to have 3 piles spliced and ready to drive by tomorrow, piles F123, F126, and F127. He observed the rest of the days operation.

As of 2:30 PM, they had F123 in place and the guide plates welded on the top and bottom piles helping secure the top pile.

I wrote and reviewed diaries the rest of the morning and prepared a package of paperwork to give to anyone that may come observe the operations in the field that are not familiar with them.

I attended the 1:30 PM meeting for the Temporary Towers.
