Worked on miscellaneous job related issues. Attended TT and Concrete Caltrans team meeting. Talked to John Gajda with CTL. Expressed my concern about top concrete on E2 being too cold and excessive temperature difference comparing to Thermal control plan. He responded that everything is OK, necessary action (closing gaps in the blankets) are taken and he do not anticipate excessive thermal cracking. He contributed initial excessive temp. differences mainly to delay in time placing between center and bottom of the pour. I asked him why the water cooling pipes were turn back on in the top lift of concrete if concrete was too cold. He responded -to avoid shutting of by mistake other pipes.
