Date: October 12, 2007

---

October 7, 2007 – fair  
Sunday – left for Airport at 0900 and flew out of SFO to Shanghai by way of Narita, Japan

October 8, 2007 – Rainy  
Arrived at Shanghai at 2130 local time and checked into hotel at 2300

October 9, 2007 – fair  
Traveled from Hotel to visit the Shanghai-Pudong Cable Co. facility with the members of "Team China". This facility appeared adequate, and any questions we had were answered. Apparently another facility is being built where the actual cables for the SAS will be fabricated. Arrived back at the hotel around 1630.

October 10, 2007 – fair  
Left hotel at 0545 by bus to travel to the ZPMC facility. Much more activity than when we visited in March. Tower building has been completed and work on the tower mockups is underway. Met with both Construction and METS staff while on the island, leaving at 1500. We arrived back at the hotel around 1700.

October 11, 2007 – fair  
Met with Construction "Team China" personnel at the Marriot Apts. Office. Good discussion of risks, and communication issues. Talked about safety, staffing, risk assessment, communication, and NCR processing. Agreed to weekly phone conf of Thursday afternoon 1600 (Stateside) which is 0700 Friday AM in China.

October 12, 2007 – fair, smoggy  
Packed and went to the airport. 1430 flight to Sapporo, Japan. We arrived at 1830 and were met by Ron Brasel of METS and took the train to our hotel in Otaru. We checked in around 2030.
