On this date Caltrans OSM Quality Assurance Inspector George Goulet was present during the times noted above for observations relative to the work being performed.

Bay 10

This QA Inspector randomly observed the following work in progress in Bay 10:

SMAW welding of weld joint ED1-A6003-8-44 located on PCMK east tower, strut. Welder was identified as 057258. ZPMC QC was identified as CWI Wang Chuan Qing (QC1). Assisting QC1 at this location and appearing to be monitoring the welding and recording data was ZPMC Yuan Hui Gang, who was not a CWI. The welding variables recorded by QC1's assistant appeared to comply with WPS-B-T-2113. Also present at this location and appearing to be monitoring the welding operation was ABF Representative Kong Xian Hui.

SAW welding of weld joint NSTL4-3B/L-1A located outside PCMK north tower, lift 4, skin C to skin D, between approximately 114.5M and 120M elevation. Welder was identified as 040489. ZPMC QC was identified as QC1. The welding variables recorded by QC appeared to comply with WPS-B-T-2221-C-U2b-S-2. Also at this location and appearing to be monitoring the welding operation was ABF Representative Li Nan.

SAW welding of weld joint NSTL4-3B/L-1A located outside PCMK north tower, lift 4, skin A to skin E, between approximately 122M and 129M elevation. Welder was identified as 040460. ZPMC QC was identified as QC1. The welding variables recorded by QC appeared to comply with WPS-B-T-2221-C-U2b-S-2. Also at this location and appearing to be monitoring the welding operation was ABF Representative Li Nan.

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SAW welding of weld joint NSTL4-3B/L-1A located outside PCMK north tower, lift 4, skin A to skin E, between approximately 129M and 136M elevation. Welder was identified as 052917. ZPMC QC was identified as QC1. The welding variables recorded by QC appeared to comply with WPS-B-T-2221-C-U2b-S-2. Also at this location and appearing to be monitoring the welding operation was ABF Representative Li Nan.

SAW welding of weld joint NSTL4-3B/L-1A located outside PCMK north tower, lift 4, skin A to skin E, between approximately 138M and 144M elevation. Welder was identified as 040252. ZPMC QC was identified as QC1. The welding variables recorded by QC appeared to comply with WPS-B-T-2221-C-U2b-S-2. Also at this location and appearing to be monitoring the welding operation was ABF Representative Li Nan.

ZPMC personnel performing magnetic particle testing inside PCMK south tower, lift 4, skin B, on the borttom side of 116M single diaphragm.

SMAW welding of temporary alignment plates located outside PCMK north tower, lift 3, skin A at the lift 2/3 connection area. Welder was identified as 053469. ZPMC QC was identified as QC1. Assisting QC1 at this location and appearing to be monitoring the welding and recording data was ZPMC Jiang Xiao Bo, who was not a CWI. The welding variables recorded by QC1's assistant appeared to comply with WPS-B-P-2114.

Unless otherwise noted, all work observed on this date appeared to generally comply with applicable contract documents.
