On this day CALTRANS OSM Quality Assurance (QA) Inspector Raghavendra Reddy was present during the times noted above for observations relative to the fabrication of the SAS Superstructure being performed by Zhenhua Port Machinery Company (ZPMC) at Changxing Island in Shanghai, China. QA observed and/or found the following:

This QA Inspector observed the following work in progress:

OBG TRIAL ASSEMBLY:

This QA Inspector with Mr. Ganguly, conducted field surveying at the OBG Trial Assembly area to measure the final position of OBG Lifts 10 and 11, Segments 10A through 11A east and west.

The survey conducted will provide dimensional verification for the aforementioned segments to include overall top deck flatness, position and orientation by obtaining measurements to permanent control points that represent the longitudinal control lines of girders, and transverse control lines of the floor beams. The preliminary dimensional verifications are not showing any major areas of concern based on the published dimensional tolerances.

- 1) Total Station.
- 2) Mini Prism.
- 3) Spherically Mounted Retro-reflectors (SMR).
