

Standard Environmental Reference Surface Transportation Act Crosswalk

The surface transportation reauthorization act, Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century (MAP-21), became effective on October 1, 2012. MAP-21 authorizes the federal surface transportation programs for highways, highway safety, and transit and provides funding of over \$105 billion for fiscal years (FY) 2013 and 2014.

The Standard Environmental Reference (SER) has been updated to reflect the changes made by MAP-21. Additionally, the SER was updated to refer to United States Code sections instead of referring to specific sections of both MAP-21 and SAFETEA-LU. The following crosswalk identifies these changes and should be used as a reference for changes in the SER.
