Debtor Accounts

A debtor account allows customers to receive monthly billing for STARS2, Single Trip (faxed), Variance, Annual and Repetitive permits. A debtor account number (DAN) is your numeric identifier for your debtor account.

Requirements:

- 1) Must be located within the United States.
- 2) Must have Caltrans approved permits issued within the past 12 months.
 - A minimum of five (5) Caltrans approved permits is required for trucking companies.
 - A minimum of ten (10) Caltrans approved permits is required for permit service companies.

Note: Companies who do not meet these requirements do not qualify for a debtor account.

To obtain a debtor account, mail to the address above or email debtor.account.admin@dot.ca.gov the following information to the Transportation Permits Issuance Branch:

 - c. Mailing Address
 - d. Phone Number
 - e. Fax Number
- 2. Contact Person
 - a. Name
 - b. Phone Number
- 3. Federal Taxpayer ID Number

After the Caltrans Accounting Division contacts you with your debtor account number, you may use it on your permit applications, or use it to apply for a STARS2 account.
